We ask that all people in your group arrive together. If this is not possible, separate reservations will need to be made and a new main contact name provided.

When necessary seating may be assigned to ensure two-meter social distancing between groups. Masks are required to worn at all times while in church buildings.

All Mass times and church capacity are subject to change if directed by the Province of New Brunswick.
