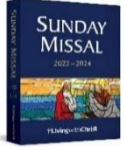

Development and Peace Campaign: Development and Peace – Caritas Canada invites us to “Stand for the Land” with a focus on Honduras in Central America. We’re asked to advocate with land and water defenders threatened by powerful mining interests. Some community members have been jailed and killed for resisting an open-pit iron mine heavily polluting a national park and rivers.
