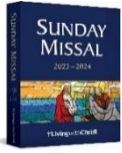
Our Lady of Peace Parish Adoration Schedule

The Frauds & Scams presentation offered by the Fredericton Police Force discusses common frauds and scams that are circulating in Fredericton. The presentation is designed to be engaging using examples of relevant cases in Fredericton and examples from the audience.

Along with examples of frauds to educate the audience, general red flags to watch out for are discussed as well. Cst. Mike Bamford has been a Community Liaison Officer with the Fredericton Police Force. He has been a police officer for 20 years, the last 13 in Fredericton.
