Walking Together: Pope Francis Canada 2022 ~ Pope Francis will make a pastoral visit to Canada from July 24 to 29. The Pope's visit will provide a unique opportunity for him, once again, to listen and dialogue with Indigenous Peoples, to express his heartfelt closeness and to address the impact of colonization and the participation of the Catholic

Church in the operation of residential schools throughout Canada. The Pope will celebrate Holy Mass on Tuesday, July 26th at Commonwealth Stadium, Edmonton, Alberta at 1:15 pm (Atlantic Time) and Thursday, July 28th at The National Shrine of Ste. In conjunction with the Pope's visit to Canada on July 28th, a prayer service is planned in the Mary Sullivan Room of the Monsignor Boyd Centre at St. Dunstan's Church.
