Easter Message From Our Pastor

The Tomb Was Empty

On the third day those first followers arrived at the tomb and they stood amazed, not understanding. How could they know that all their hopes would come true, and that they would see their world transformed? How like them we are. We still do not yet understand what the resurrection really is...and this is ok.

There are things that we cannot know about this present life, that we believe will be revealed to us in the fullness of time. What we do know, what we can see now, is that the promise of the resurrection has continued on to us. This life, a life lived in Christ, is a gift, and we are given this gift to share. We are asked to pour ourselves out like him, becoming givers of the gifts we have received.

Our bodies, these earthen vessels, contain a gift of the Spirit. We let Christ fill us with the Spirit of Faith that reveals to us a possibility beyond what we see. We receive a Spirit of Hope that allows us to imagine new possibilities for humanity. We accept the Spirit of Love that allows us to serve and share **JOYFULLY** without thought of return for ourselves.

We are vessels containing the Spirit God has given to us. What we know about containers is that they were made to be emptied. Water buckets, bread baskets, oil jars, wineskins, perfume bottles, wombs, tombs...from the mundane to the sacred, all are poured out. We are made to empty ourselves, to offer what is in our hearts and minds, to pour it out, in loving witness and praise to the One God.

Whatever Christ has placed in you, you have not fully received it until you have learned to share it. In self-giving, we begin to understand that we are one body, one people. When we share the Grace we have been given with others, we may see the world transform before our eyes. In Jesus's resurrection is the promise, is the proof: all that God has promised will be made true in this One Body of Christ. Through our belief in the resurrection our world is still being transformed.

Christ is risen, Alleluia, Alleluia. He is truly risen, Alleluia, Alleluia.
